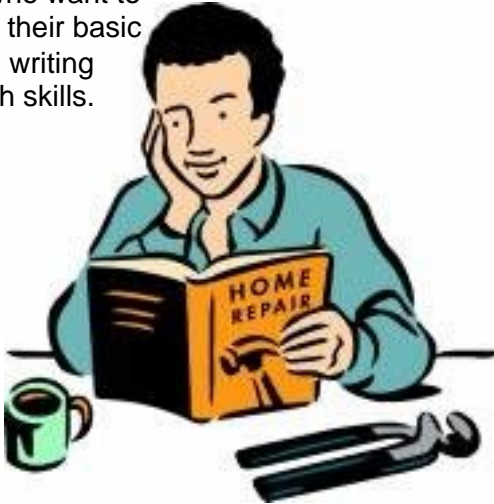


Who Are the Learners?

Laubach Literacy New Brunswick's trained volunteer tutors are matched with adult learners in a one-on-one setting to improve their reading and writing skills. Our tutors provide a helping hand, encouragement and sensitivity while using the Each One Teach One method.



Changing Lives with Laubach

Some success stories of literacy programs have included helping adults to become independent learners, to meet personal goals, to obtain academic skills, to obtain social and team work skills, improved attitudes and self esteem, improved family life and better health.



How it all Began

In 1930, world-renowned literacy pioneer, Dr. Frank Laubach, developed a system to teach adults to read and write based on the "Each One Teach One" method. In Canada, the first Laubach training workshop was held in 1970. In 1975, Laubach Literacy of New Brunswick was incorporated as a community-based, non-profit organization. The Keswick Valley Laubach Literacy Council began in 1995.

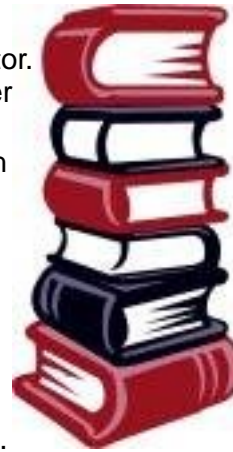
